Dear Parents and Carers,

End of Term Update

As we approach the end of term, I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the upcoming events we will be having in school alongside certain changes that will be going ahead from January 2021.

Changes to the school timetable

By now you should have recieved the letter sent last week regarding the changes to the school timetable. Starting from Wednesday 6th January 2021, school will close at 1:30PM to allow time for an effective and thorough clean of school. Should you require any further information regarding this, please do not hesitate to contact the school office who will be happy to provide you with a copy of the original letter.

On reflection, I understand that for many of you this may be a difficult adjustment. I have also acknowledged some of your concerns regarding children missing time in education. Due to this, it has been decided to extend the school day by 15 minutes on a Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Therefore, on these days, school will close at 3:15PM (starting from Monday 4th January 2021). In addition to this, children's lunch time will also be reduced by 5 minutes in an attempt to maximise their time in the classroom. Although these alterations may seem small, over the course of the week this should help account for the early finish on a Wednesday.

The wellbeing of all the children at Elm Tree is paramount for me. As expressed in the letter sent last week, I hope that with a comprehensive cleaning system in place from January, this will help limit the closure of class bubbles and make way for a successful year. With more children remaining in school, I am confident that the disruption we have experienced over the last 9 months will not carry over into the new year.
